AGENDA ITEM - VII - A

Airport Management and the Secretary/Treasurer will provide an overview of the Financial Report for the two months ending November 30, 2018. Due to the timing of the December Board Meeting, estimates were used when possible.

Total Operating Revenues as of November 30, 2018 were \$738,817 an increase of \$51,412 or 7.5% to budget. This increase in revenue year to date is attributable to a seasonal increase in Customs Facility Revenue.

Total Non-Operating Revenues and Capital Contributions as of November 30, 2018 were \$0.

Total Operating Expenses as of November 30, 2018 were \$480,343 a decrease of \$50,650 or 9.5% compared to budget. Significant variances in expenses compared to budget for the two months ending November 30, 2018 are as follows:

- Marketing expenditures are up \$32,710 or 107.5% to budget, primarily due to onetime donations made to the Civil Air Patrol and BRAA Scholarship Fund.
- Project expenditures are down \$84,490 or 99.9% to budget, primarily due to the ATCT rehabilitation project.
- Legal Service expenditures for the month of November where not received in time for the financial report. Year to date expenditures are detailed below, including a breakdown of costs for board member related matters and capital projects.

Total Capital Expenditures as of November 30, 2018 were \$196,661. The majority of Capital Expenditures were attributable to Task 40 – Customs Facility and Task 41 – Security Enhancements of the Capital Improvement Program. Of the total \$196,661 in Capital Expenditures, \$1,300 were attributable to project-related legal fees, while \$11,070 were attributable to Capital Outlay.

The Collings Foundation anticipates displaying World War II vintage aircraft including a Boeing B-17 Flying Fortress, a Consolidated B-24 Liberator, and a North American P-51 Mustang. Flight experiences will also be available.

Local representatives of The Collings Foundation are working with Signature Flight Support and Airport Management to ensure the safety of the public attending the event and the safe and uninterrupted operation of the Airport.

Airport Management recommends Resolution Number 12-33-18 of the Boca Raton Airport Authority authorizing conditional approval for Signature Flight Support to host a Special Event on their leasehold from January 21 – 24, 2019 for the Collings Foundation "Wings of Freedom Tour" contingent upon receipt of a certificate of insurance and endorsements in accordance with the Authority's Minimum Standards and submission of applicable safety, security and barricade plans.



Chart 3: Month of November 2018 deliveries of Jet A in gallons compared to November 2017 deliveries of Jet A.




Chart 4: Month of November 2018 deliveries of Avgas in gallons compared to November 2017 deliveries of Avgas.




Chart 5: Noise concerns submitted via telephone, email, or on our website are tracked by quadrant where the noise concern occurred in relation to the airport.




Chart 6: Type of noise concern and/or if it occurred during a Temporary Flight Restriction (TFR).



RUNWAY DEPARTURE HEADING BY DIRECTION




