CUSTOMS OPERATIONS BY AIRCRAFT














The Boca Raton Airport is a general aviation airport committed to serving the piston, turboprop, and jet aircraft communities.

This varied mix of operations is represented in the flight operations that cleared customs at BCT over the past 12 months. Of the total 1491 aircraft that cleared, 347 were piston engines, 208 were turboprop, and 936 were jets.




CUSTOMS OPERATIONS MONTHLY REVIEW





Since its opening at the end of May 2018, the Boca Raton Customs and Border Protection Facility has processed over 6,800 passengers. These clearances follow the normal travel and usage patterns of the airport, peaking during winter and spring, then decreasing as the summer months approach.
