SMALL JET (LESS THAN 20K MTOW)



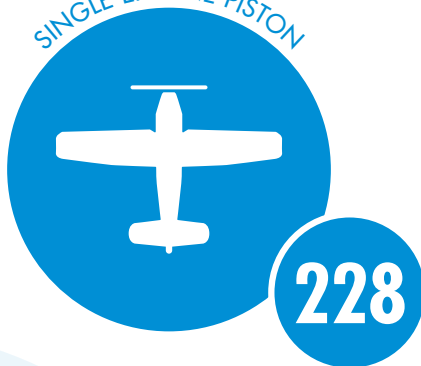
MEDIUM JET (20K - 60K MTOW)

The Boca Raton Airport is a general aviation airport committed to serving the piston, turboprop, and jet aircraft communities.

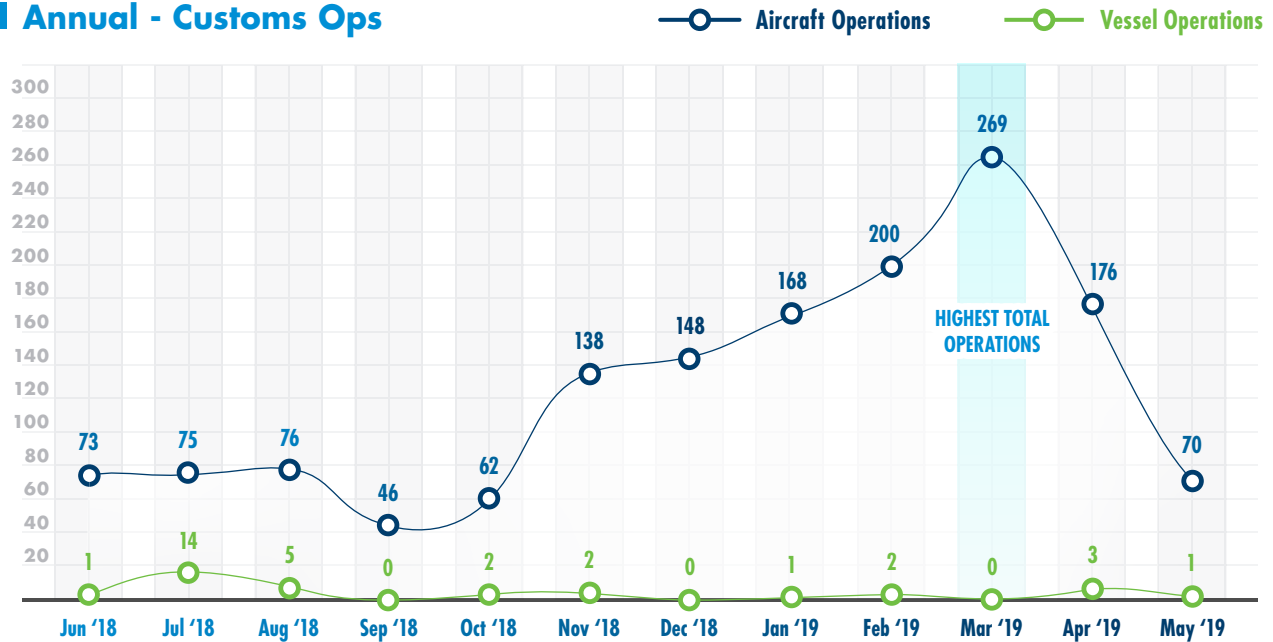

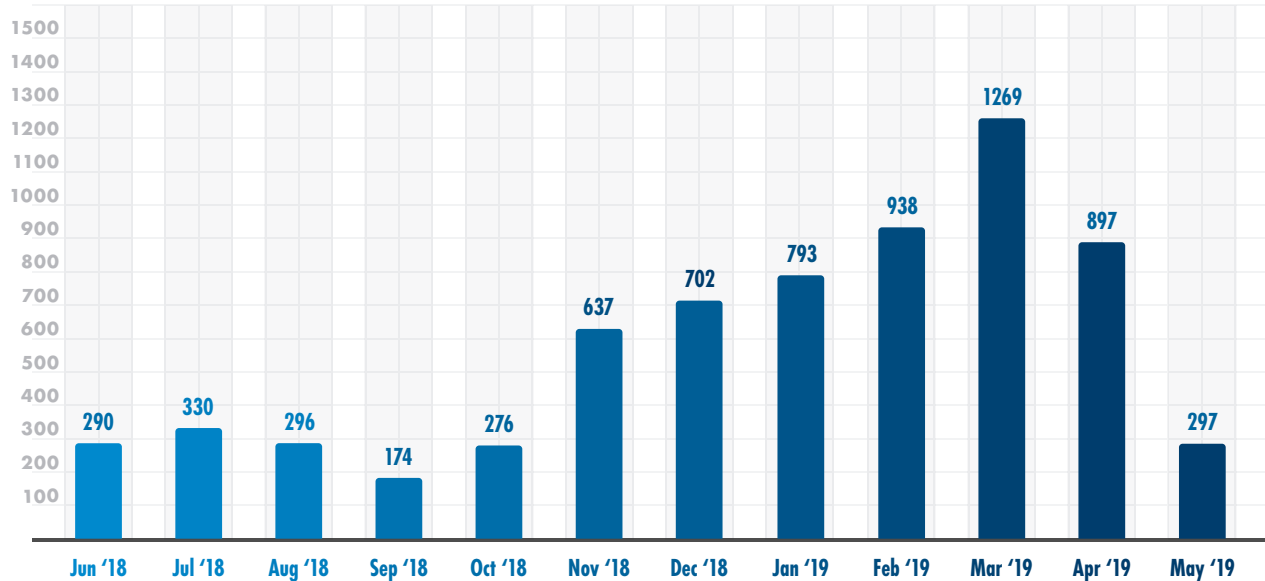

## Annual - Customs Ops

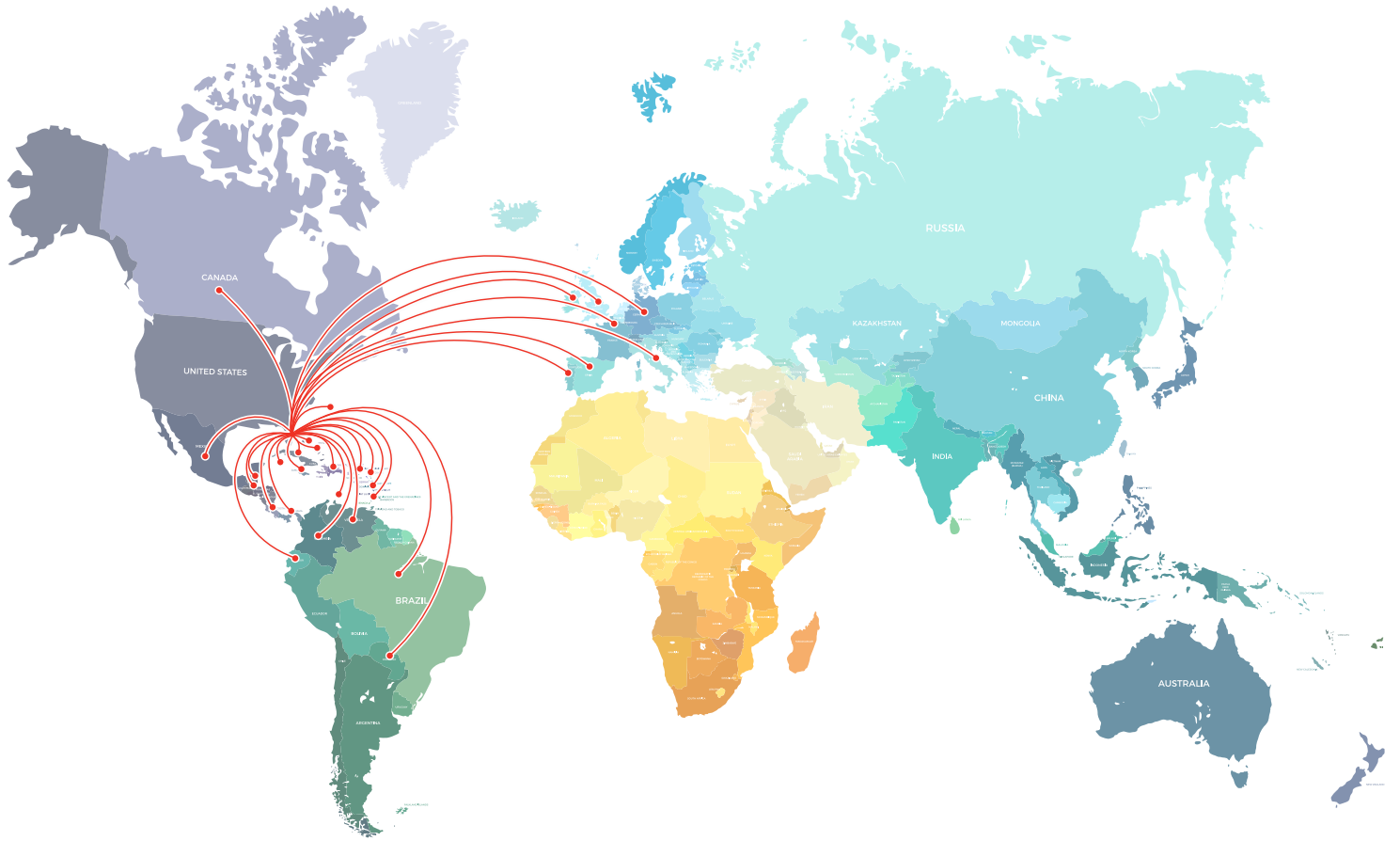


## Annual - Passengers



Since its opening at the end of May 2018, the Boca Raton Customs and Border Protection Facility has processed **over 6,800 passengers**. These clearances follow the normal travel and usage patterns of the airport, peaking during winter and spring, then decreasing as the summer months approach.
