## **AGENDA ITEM – V - B**

Airport Management provides an overview of the Noise Abatement/Operations Summary for the month of March. This report is derived from the Air Traffic Control Tower operations report.

During the month of March 2022, there were 6,673 operations reported by the Tower, which is a 21% decrease from total operations reported in March 2021.

Deliveries of Jet A fuel were up 5% compared to March of 2021. Avgas deliveries saw a 32% increase compared to March 2021.

There were 1,254 noise calls made by 10 different households received on the Airport Authority Noise Hotline and Online Noise Reporting Form.

During the month, 232 aircraft cleared Customs from 21 different countries and there was one vessel clearing. There were 72 afterhours clearings. Of these flights, 44 cleared on Tuesdays and Wednesdays, when the facility is normally closed.
