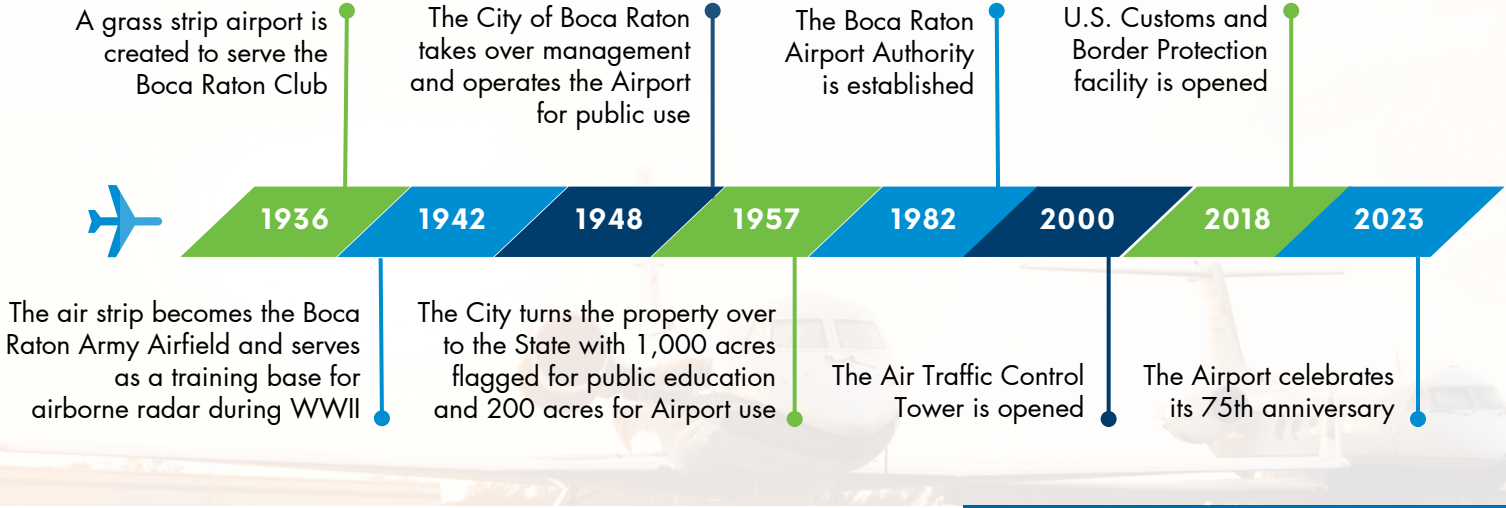

AIRPORT MANAGEMENT

- **The Boca Raton Airport Authority** is a special independent district of the State of Florida. The Authority Board is comprised of seven members. Five are appointed in even years by the City of Boca Raton and two are appointed in odd years by Palm Beach County. Each member serves a two-year term.
- The Airport is **self-sustaining**. Funding for the Airport comes from long-term land leases, fuel flowage revenue, and Customs and Border Protection clearing fees.
- **Infrastructure improvements** are funded by FDOT and FAA matching grants.

UPCOMING PROJECTS

Airfield Lighting & Signage

Replacement of all airfield lighting, signage, underground cabling, constant current regulators, and related hardware.

Airport Master Plan

Blueprint for Airport improvements according to the FAA requirements. Includes a Stormwater Master Plan.

Airport Observation Deck

Construction of an Observation Area next to the Administration Building, expected to be completed by early 2024.

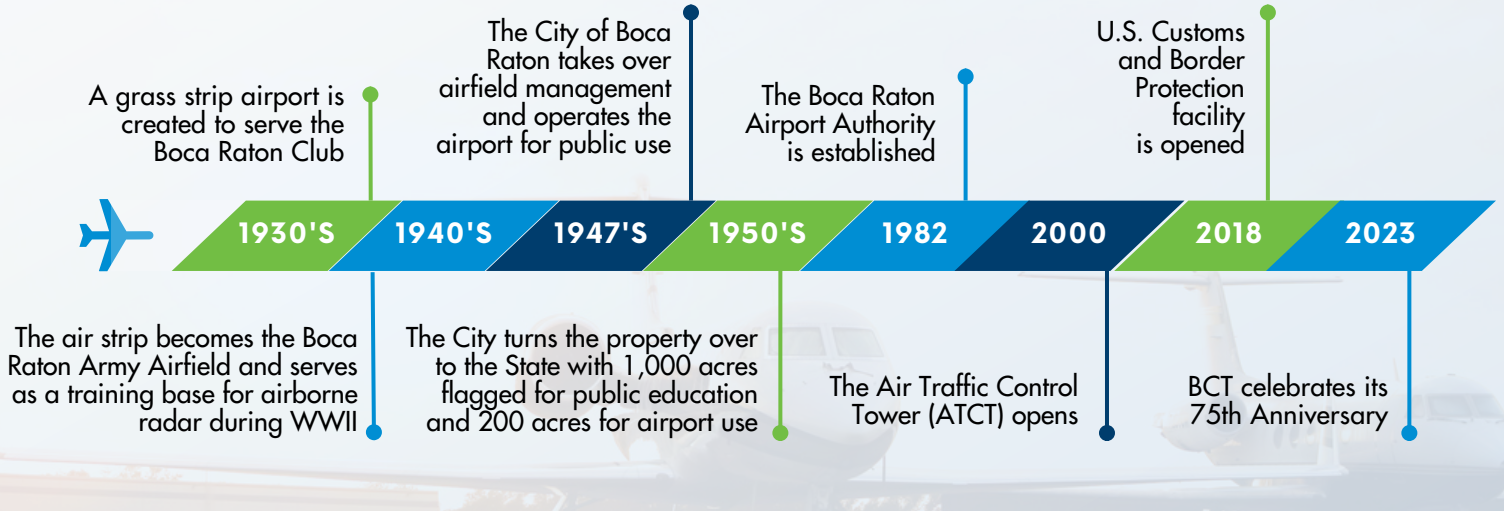

CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION SERVICES NEARLY 8,000 FLIGHTS TO AND FROM **ABOUT 70 COUNTRIES** HAVE CLEARED CUSTOMS SINCE THE FACILITY OPENED IN 2018.

UPCOMING PROJECTS

Airfield Lighting and Signage

This project will consist of the replacement of all airfield lighting, signage, underground cabling, constant current regulators, and related hardware at the Boca Raton Airport.

Airport Master Plan

This project will outline a blueprint for airport improvements according to the FAA requirements and includes a Stormwater Master Plan.

Observation Area

This project involves the construction of an Airport Observation Area adjacent to the BRAA Administration Building. The project is expected to be completed in early 2024.
